Welcome Buyers, Family, Friends and Exhibitors!

This year there is a total of 160 lots in the sale. The first 16 lots are our Grand and Reserve Champion projects. Once the Champion lots have sold, we will then move on to systematically selling livestock and homemaking lots according to their placings in their respective classes, i.e. all 1st place animals will sell before all 2nd place. Senior and Junior 1st place food items will be interspersed throughout the Sale.

The sale list is comprised of 20 steers, 11 lambs, 35 hogs, 33 goats, 18 pens of rabbits, 14 pens of broilers, 12 senior division foods, 12 junior division foods, Grand and Reserve Ag Mechanics Projects and the Grand Champion Junior and the Grand Champion Senior Craft. The final lot will be the Adult Best in Food and all proceeds from this lot will benefit the BCJLHS Scholarship Fund.

The lots in sale whether it is a steer, lamb, hog, goat, rabbits, broilers, food or crafts will sell by the lot. If the auctioneer is asking for a \$750 bid for a pen of rabbits, he is asking for \$750 total for that lot.

Reserve Grand Champion may NOT sell for more than the Grand Champion and placing animals may NOT sell for more than the Reserve Grand Champion of that division.

This is a premium sale, there will be no change of ownership except by negotiations after the sale between buyers and sellers. There are quite a few of our exhibitors that go on to major shows with their animals that they bring to the BCJLHS. Any homemaking lots and the Ag mechanic lots are the exceptions to this rule.

The buyer sheets for each lot will be at the table at the front of the Expo center. If you would like to add money to a lot, the upcoming 20 lots are available for your signature and the amount you would like to spend. Once the lot is in the sale ring if you would to add on more to that particular lot please raise your buyer number and state the amount you would like to add on.

The auction purchase price will be tax deductible since it is considered a donation, the BCJLHS is a recognized 501c (3) non-profit organization.

We also have an "Add-on" option for each exhibitor, add-ons may be filled out for any lot in the sale or for any exhibitor that participated in the show and did not make the sale. There is a separate table and sheet for add-ons.
